Members residing on reserve and wishing to vote by Mail in Ballot must request their voting package directly from the Electoral Officer. Voting by electronic ballot will also be available. The Electors List has been posted for review at the Whitefish River First Nation Band Administration building and community centre as well as at other location. Copies are also available directly from the Electoral Officer upon request.

Eligible Electors who desire information from Candidates may provide approval to the Electoral Officer to release their personal contact information to the Candidates.
